- The role of fake news in global crises, such as pandemics and climate change;
- Information policy, and propaganda from an international perspective;
- Legal, regulatory, and ethical frameworks for addressing and mitigating disinformation;
- Educational initiatives and technological innovations for addressing disinformation;
- Relationships between disinformation, conspiracy theories, and social polarization;
- The impact of disinformation on democratic processes and national security;
- Disinformation as a geopolitical tool.

Submission Guidelines:

- Articles may be submitted in Polish or English.
- Word count: 6,000–10,000 words.
- Manuscripts should adhere to the journal's <u>submission guidelines</u>.
- All submissions will undergo a double-blind peer-review process.
- Articles must be submitted via the journal's website by May 5, 2025.
